

NFL-STAR BRANDON NOBLE NAMED DREAM BOWL IV GAME AMBASSADOR

After college, Brandon signed as an undrafted free agent with the San Francisco 49ers. He was allocated to the Barcelona Dragons of NFL Europe where he led them to the World Bowl V championship. In 1999, Brandon signed as a free agent with the Dallas Cowboys. He starred for 4 seasons in Dallas finishing his Cowboy career with 32 consecutive starts. In 2002, Brandon signed with the Washington Redskins. Injuries cut short his Redskin career and he retired in 2006.

Brandon turned to coaching and he has coached at all levels of football including with the D-1 Temple Owls and the Coastal Carolina Chanticleers, D-II West Chester University, and the UFL's Omaha Nighthawks.

Brandon's success story fits the message and mission of the Dream Bowl which is the premier non-FBS college all-star game in the country. The Dream Bowl IV rosters are made up of the best players from the FCS, D-II, and D-III divisions of college football. The mission of the Dream Bowl is to provide these athletes the opportunity to promote their skills in front of NFL and CFL scouts for their dream of playing at the next level. Cutting Edge Sports Management Director of Player Development, Charles Stuller is excited to have Brandon as part of this year's event. "Brandon's determination to go from undrafted free agent to playing in Europe to becoming a starter in the NFL is an inspiration to all athletes looking to make it to the NFL.
